### Mild Roasted Coffee

- 1. Mysore** - The most celebrated of Indian coffees. A velvety richness, low in acidity and mild in flavour.
- 2. Costa Rican** - A mild coffee with an increasing popularity. Excellent as a gentle all day coffee.
- 3. Breakfast Blend** - Is traditionally a light and mild coffee.

### Medium Roasted Coffee

- 4. Kenya Peaberry** - A 'peaberry' is produced when only one half of the coffee cherry develops. Good aroma with an excellent balance of flavours.
- 5. San Agustin Colombian** - This has good sweetness and a well rounded taste, a coffee for the true connoisseur. Perfect without milk.
- 7. Blue Mountain Blend** - An excellent all day drinking coffee which imitates the original Jamaican Blue Mountain.
- 8. Colombian** - A Medellin Excebo Colombian coffee. Medium roasted to produce a full nutty flavour.
- 9. Brazilian Santos** - The best of the Brazilian coffees, medium roasted to produce a good all day drinking coffee.

### Stronger Medium Roasted Coffee

- 10. Monsoon Malabar** - Produced in Southern India this is aged in the Monsoon winds for a few days which gives it a distinctive flavour, free from acidity.
- 11. Old Brown Java** - Is aged for a minimum of three years to produce a sweet flavour with a good body and strength. Excellent as an after dinner coffee.

### Dark Roasted Coffee

- 12. Italian Blend** - A full flavoured pure Arabica blend, high roasted to give a strong and Continental flavour.
- 13. Full Mountain Roast** - High roasted as the Italian Blend but with a smooth and rich flavour.

### Other Coffees


**14. Swiss Water Decaffeinated** - A fine Central American coffee which is decaffeinated with the Swiss Water process that uses no chemicals.

### Ceylon Tea

- 16. Ceylon Water Decaffeinated Tea** - One of the best as it retains most of its flavour after processing.
- 17. Ceylon Orange Pekoe** - A light tea, most refreshing with little tannin, good black or use just a dash of milk.

### Indian Tea

- 18. Assam Tippy Orthodox** - Malty and full bodied. Very popular in Britain as a good strong tea.
- 19. Darjeeling TGFOP Best** - From the foothills of the Himalayas where the climate is cool and wet which results in a light and delicate flavour.

### Other Teas

**21. Kenya B.O.P** - The best of the African teas. An excellent clean tasting tea with good colour, a more gentle alternative to breakfast tea.

### Chinese and Formosan Teas

- 22. Keemun Yi Hong** - Malty and full flavoured. Keemun became known as the English Breakfast Tea in the 18th century.
- 23. Black Dragon Oolong** - Oolong is to China what Darjeeling is to India. Semi-fermented with all the flavour of a green tea. Never use milk!
- 24. Jasmine Monkey King** - One of China's most famous teas. It is believed to aid digestion and is scented with Jasmine Blossom.
- 25. Imperial Earl Grey** - This is a blend of Black China Tea and natural oil of Bergamot resulting in a very popular and refreshing brew.
- 26. Lapsang Souchong** - An unusual tea with a strong and smokey flavour, created by the drying process.
- 27. Advent Of Winter Tea** - This warming winter tea is a blend of China teas, orange peels, rose petals, cinnamon and cloves.
- 28. Tropical Green Tea** - A blend of passion fruits, guava and mango resulting in a pleasant tasting tea which is low in caffeine.
- 29. Gunpowder Tea** - A subtle and refreshing green tea. Historically, the leaves were rolled into small balls, which resembled lead shot.

### Japanese Tea

**30. Sencha** - A quality green tea, light and refreshing. The majority is grown for the Japanese market and little is exported.

**31. Tea of Life (Pai Mu Tan)** - A Fujian Province green tea said to promote good health. Light and delicate, very low in caffeine. **£2.95**

**32. Black Dragon Oolong SILVER TIP** - Known as "Liquid Sunshine". Selected from the new, unopened shoots. Pure heaven! **£2.95**
